Here are a few suggestions to consider to receive maximum benefit before and while interviewing a podcast guest.

- 1. Find someone you find incredibly interesting. Not only will your guest feed off of your heightened level of engagement, but your audience also will too.
- 2. Know as much about your guest as possible. The more you know, the better. Your guest will appreciate that you've done your homework. Keep a cheat sheet of facts closeby.
- 3. Create a pre-call process or checklist. List each step you will encounter leading up to and during the podcast.
- 4. **Have a list of questions ready**. Have a pre-call conversation with your guest and share the questions you'll be asking. During the interview, have the list available to ensure you are staying on point.
- 5. Stay in control. During the interview, you are in charge of maintaining the tempo of the conversation. Don't let the guest control the pace.
- 6. Don't interrupt; pay attention. A sawy guest will know when you are not listening to their responses. Listen intently as they speak. Don't let your next question hamper your concentration.
- 7. **It'll never be perfect**. Even the best interviewers look for ways to improve their skills. Re-listen to all of your podcast interviews and make adjustments and improvements to your craft.
